In December 1995, a group of concerned citizens met to establish a long range plan for an educational foundation. A seed grant of \$2,000 was received from Alabama Power Company “for academic purposes not bricks and mortar.”



On May 9, 1996 the Cullman City Schools Foundation was born. During the first year the Foundation raised \$40,000 and awarded \$32,423 in grant money to city educators.

Since 1996, over \$140,000 has been awarded to multiple city educators through various grants.

The rich heritage of Cullman’s schools reflect the values and ethics of generations of residents who have entrusted their most precious treasure, their children, to the city’s public school system. Keeping a keen eye on their mission, the educators prepare young people to be well-adjusted citizens who make positive contributions to a democratic society.



Cullman City Schools consistently rank in the top ten academically among Alabama schools. All five city schools are accredited by the Southern Association of Schools. Our elementary schools were the first public elementary schools in the state to be accredited.
